SESSION DESCRIPTION

As the global energy transition accelerates, nations and companies face the challenge of reducing carbon emissions while ensuring reliable energy supply. Hydrocarbons remain a cornerstone of the global economy, but how can we achieve a sustainable balance between their use and decarbonization goals?

This session will explore strategies for reducing the carbon footprint of the oil and gas industry, new advancements in carbon capture, utilization, and storage, and successful transformation cases from leading energy companies.

FORMAT PARALLEL SESSION

A designated seating area near the stage will be available for speakers before they take their seats on stage. Once the session starts, a room producer will signal both the speakers and the moderator to proceed to the stage.

Interactive format of the session promotes equal and informal exchange of views among participants. To ensure a lively and engaging discussion, we kindly ask speakers to move away from lengthy, prewritten speeches and instead embrace a dynamic, interactive dialogue. We encourage thoughtprovoking exchanges that bring fresh perspectives to the session's topic. Towards the end of the session, the moderator may select questions from the audience to further enrich the conversation.

If necessary, there is an option to use short presentations.

Simultaneous interpretation in English and Russian will be available throughout the session.

RUN OF SHOW

00-05 The moderator will introduce the topic and give a brief introduction of each speaker

- 05-30 Initial question posed: each speaker given approximately 5 minutes to respond
- 30-45 Open discussion with follow-up questions posed at the moderator's discretion
- 45-55 Questions from the audience
- 55-60 Summary and concluding remarks by the moderator
